## 10 killed as flood rescue boats capsized

At least 10 flood victims, including children, were killed when three boats capsized in Pakistan's Punjab province during a rescue operation, an official said on Friday. According to an official of the Punjab Emergency Services Rescue 1122, a massive evacuation is underway in south Punjab as floodwater submerged hundreds of villages there. "During an evacuation operation, three boats near Multan and Bahawalnagar capsized, resulting in the death of 10 flood victims, including children. However, the rescuers saved 40 others from drowning," he said.

## 86 killed in Congo boat capsized

At least 86 people have died after a motorised boat capsized in northwestern Congo's Equateur Province, state media reported on Friday. The accident occurred on Wednesday in Basankusu territory. Most of the victims were students. It was not immediately clear what caused the accident although the state media blamed it on "improper loading and night navigation."

## Armani told heirs to sell 15% of empire

After a lifetime of spurning would-be business suitors, the late Italian designer Giorgio Armani instructed his heirs to sell a 15 per cent minority stake in his vast fashion empire, with priority to the French conglomerate LVMH, the eyewear giant Essilor-Luxottica or the cosmetics company L'Oréal. Armani gave control of 40 per cent of his business empire to his longtime collaborator and head of menswear Leo Dell'Orco, and another 15 per cent each to niece Silvana Armani, the head of womenswear, and nephew Andrea Camerana, according to his business will posted online Friday by the Italian daily *La Repubblica*.

## Lebanon nod to Starlink licences

Lebanon has granted a license to Elon Musk's Starlink to provide satellite internet services in the crisis-hit country known for its crumbling infrastructure. The announcement was made late Thursday by Information Minister Paul Morcos who said Starlink will provide internet services throughout Lebanon via satellites operated by Musk's SpaceX. Musk had spoken with Lebanon's President Joseph Aoun 3 months earlier by phone and told him about his interest in working in the country's telecommunications and internet sectors.

## South Koreans released from US return home

Incheon (South Korea): A plane carrying more than 300 South Korean workers released after days of detention in Georgia landed in South Korea on Friday.

TV footage showed the charter plane, a Boeing 747-8i from Korean Air, landing in Incheon International Airport, just west of Seoul, on Friday. The footage later showed workers, some wearing masks, passing an arrival hall, with senior officials clapping hands.

# We've him: Trump says Kirk 'killer' held

The suspect in the Charlie Kirk assassination has been captured, President Donald Trump said on Friday in an announcement representing a significant breakthrough in the investigation into a targeted killing that raised fresh alarms about political violence in US.

"With a high degree of certainty, we have him," Trump announced in a live interview on Fox News Channel. He said a minister also involved with law enforcement turned the suspect in to authorities.

"Somebody that was very close to him said, Hmm, that's him," Trump said.

The suspect in custody in connection with Kirk's killing is a 22-year-old from Utah, a law enforcement official told The Associated Press. Authorities have identified the suspect as Tyler Robinson, said the official, who was not authorised to discuss the ongoing investigation and spoke on the condition of anonymity.

The FBI and the Justice De-

partment did not immediately comment, but a news conference in Utah, where the killing took place on a college campus this week, was planned for later Friday. News of the arrest came hours after the FBI and state officials had pleaded for public help by releasing additional photographs of the suspect, a move that seemed to indicate that law enforcement was uncertain of the person's whereabouts. Kirk was killed by a single shot in what police said was a targeted attack and Utah's governor called a political assassination. Kirk co-founded the nonprofit political organisation Turning Point USA, based in Arizona.

Authorities recovered a high-powered, bolt-action rifle near the scene of the shooting and had said the shooter jumped off a roof and vanished into the nearby woods afterward.

Kirk had been speaking at a debate hosted by Turning Point at Utah Valley University at the time of Wednesday's shooting. He was taken to a local hospital and was pronounced dead hours later.

"He wanted to help young people, and he didn't deserve this," Trump said on Friday. "He was really a good person."

Federal investigators and state officials on Thursday had released photos and a video of the person they

believe is responsible. Kirk was shot as he spoke to a crowd gathered in a courtyard at the university in Orem.

More than 7,000 leads and tips had poured in, officials said. Authorities have yet to publicly name the suspect or cite a motive in the killing, the latest act of political violence to convulse the United States.

The attack, carried out in broad daylight as Kirk spoke about social issues, was captured on grisly videos that spread on social media.

The videos show Kirk, who was influential in rallying young Republican voters, speaking into a handheld microphone when suddenly a shot rings out.

Kirk reaches up with his right hand as blood gushes from the left side of his neck. Stunned spectators gasp and scream before people start running away.

Consul General D C Manju-nath told PTI that the mission is providing full consular support to the victim's family. Known as Bob to friends and family, Nagamallaiah was remembered as a loving husband, devoted father, and kind soul who touched the lives of everyone he knew.

## Breaking glass ceiling: From CJ's post to Nepal PM's chair

When she completed her Masters in Political Science from Banaras Hindu University 50 years ago, Sushila Karki may not have thought she would go on to create a record in Nepal's politics.

The 73-year-old was appointed the 24th Chief Justice of Nepal in July 2016, becoming the first and the only woman yet to occupy the post. She remained in the post for around 11 months.

"She has made a reputation of a bold and fair justice with zero tolerance to corruption," remarked Dinesh Tripathi, senior advocate. "As a bold

and determined justice, she has stood strong against corruption."

Karki faced an impeachment motion, considered to be politically biased by several stakeholders, moved by the then Sher Bahadur Deuba government, but it was later withdrawn.

Born on June 7, 1952 at Shankerpur-3 in eastern Nepal's Biratnagar, close to the Indian border, she completed her Bachelors from Mahendra Morang campus, Tribhuvan University, Nepal in 1971 before joining BHU in 1975. She returned to Tribhuvan University to earn a degree in law in 1978.

Karki spent 32 years in the

judicial profession and became a symbol of progress for women in the field. She started her law practice in Biratnagar in 1979. In between, she also served as an assistant teacher at Mahendra Multiple Campus, Dharan in 1985.

She became a senior advocate in 2007 and was appointed as an ad hoc judge in the Supreme Court in 2009. She became a permanent judge on November 18, 2010.

Karki is the eldest of seven siblings and grew up in a simple farming family in Biratnagar. She is married to Durga Prasad Subedi, an erstwhile popular leader of Nepali Congress. They had met during her days at the BHU.

## PIO motel manager beheaded in US after spat; co-worker held

A 50-year-old Indian-origin motel manager in the US was beheaded in front of his wife and son in Texas following a dispute over a washing machine, police said.

The suspect, a co-worker with a criminal record, has been arrested and charged with capital murder.

The incident took place on Wednesday morning at the Downtown Suites motel in Dallas. Chandra Mouli "Bob" Nagamallaiah, originally from Karnataka, was killed after a dispute over a broken washing machine with his 37-year-old Cuban co-worker Yordanis Cobos-Martinez, according to the Dallas Police Department.

Cobos-Martinez reportedly became enraged when Nagamallaiah asked another person to translate his instructions instead of addressing him directly. Surveillance footage showed Cobos-Martinez attacking Nagamallaiah with a machete. The victim fled toward the motel office, where his wife and 18-year-old son were present.

Nagamallaiah's wife and son tried to intervene several times, but Cobos-Martinez pushed them away and continued the attack. He then took the victim's cell phone and key card from his pockets before

again resuming the attack until Nagamallaiah's head "was removed from his body," police said in court affidavit. The suspect then kicked the [Nagamallaiah's] head twice into the parking lot and proceeded to pick it up and carry it to the dumpster and put it inside," police said.

The crime is "unthinkable", they said.

Cobos-Martinez is being held without bond. If convicted, he could face life imprisonment without parole or the death penalty.

According to official records, he has been arrested twice for auto theft in Florida and has indecency with a child and assault charges in Houston. The records also show an immigration hold.

ICE officials said Cobos-Martinez was released under supervision earlier this year due to the lack of deportation

## UK imposes fresh sanctions on Russia

France said on Friday it's deploying fighter jets to Poland and the UK announced fresh sanctions targeting Russia's oil revenues and war machine as Europe's first, measured steps to Russia's drone incursion into Poland aimed to send a signal to Moscow that any further aggression won't go unchecked.

French President Emmanuel Macron said he would deploy three advanced fighter jets to help protect Poland's airspace and NATO's eastern flank to fulfill a commitment he made to Polish Prime Minister Donald Tusk.

He said the deployment was discussed with both NATO Secretary-General Mark Rutte and British Prime Minister Keir Starmer. "The security of the European continent is our top priority. We will not yield to Russia's growing intimidation," Macron posted on X.
